DESCRIPTION

MasterSeal M869 is a hand applied, non-solvented, 2-component, self levelling polyurethane based, elastomeric coating.

FIELD OF APPLICATION

MasterSeal M869 is the waterproofing membrane for hand applied MasterSeal car park deck waterproofing system amongst other applications.

FEATURES AND BENEFITS

- monolithic no laps, welds or seams
- fully bonded
- high water vapour permeability low risk of blistering
- · excellent mechanical properties
- excellent crack bridging capability

- thermoset does not soften at elevated temperatures

SUBSTRATE PRETREATMENT

The preparation of the substrate and the use of the appropriate primer are of paramount importance. All surfaces to which MasterSeal M869 is applied must be clean and dry and free from oil, grease and loose material and any other contamination which might impair adhesion.

Primer selection will depend on substrate type. Application should take place within the re-coat interval of the primer, to which it is to be applied.

Refer to primer technical data sheet.

APPLICATION CONDITIONS

For best results, materials, substrate and air temperature should be in the range 15 - $25^{\rm o}{\rm C}$

Low temperatures will reduce flow and can impair the visual appearance of the membrane.

High temperatures will shorten the open time and can impair the appearance of the membrane.

The temperatures should not fall below the minimum stated until the material is fully cured. The temperature of the substrate must be at least 3°C above the dew point both during the application and for at least a further 6 hours (at 15°C).

APPLICATION

MasterSeal M869 is supplied in working units. Before mixing, both A and B components should be preconditioned to a temperature of 15 to 20°C.

Pour the entire contents of part A into the container of part B. mix with a low speed (ca. 300 rpm) electric drill and paddle for at least 3 minutes until homogeneous. Scrape the sides and bottom of the container several times during mixing to ensure complete mixing. Keep the mixing head submerged to avoid entrapping air.

Do not work out of the original container. Decant the mixed material into a fresh container and remix for another minute.

MasterSeal M869 is poured onto the prepared substrate and spread with a notched trowel or spreader (rubber or steel). Bubbles should be removed by rolling with a spiked roller.

COVERAGE

Typically 1.2kg/m² per mm thickness. Minimum membrane thickness: 1.5mm.

FINISHING AND CLEANING

Tools must be cleaned immediately after use with xylene or other suitable solvent.

CURING

Full cure is reached in 7 days after the application at a constant temperature of 20°C .

PACKAGING

MasterSeal M869 is supplied in 30kg working packs.

STORAGE

Store in original containers under normal warehouse conditions. Off the ground, dry and at a temperature between 5 - 30°C. Do not expose to direct sunlight.
