Coloured, latex modified cement grout for ceramic, glass mosaic, porcelain and non-moisture sensitive natural stones tiles

DESCRIPTION

MasterTile 530 is a fine coloured latex modified powder which, when mixed with water, gives a smooth, easily applied creamy paste for clean grouting of ceramic tiles. It sets to a decorative water-resistant finish.

TYPICAL PROPERTIES*

Mixed density @25°C 1777 kg/m³

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Allow at least 24 hours between fixing tiles and grouting. Mix grout powder with water to give a smooth, thick consistency.

Leave to stand for 15 minutes before using. Apply to tile joints with a squeegee, brush or sponge. Remove surplus grout with a damp sponge. When grouting is completed, polish tiles with a dry cloth.

WATER ADDITION

1.65 L per 5 kg bag 5.94 L per 18 kg bag

COVERAGE / YIELD

- 1 kg is sufficient for approximately 4 m² using standard 150 x 150 mm tiles.
- 5 kg bag mixed with 1.65 L of water yields approximately 3.75 L
- 18 kg bag mixed with 5.94 L of water yields approximately 13.50 L

WATCHPOINTS

Certain types of tile may stain when in contact with coloured cement grouts, it is therefore advisable to consult the tile manufacturer and carry out trials before use.

For natural stone tiles susceptible to staining, please contact Master Builders Solutions Technical Services.

STORAGE AND SHELF LIFE

Store out of direct sunlight, clear of the ground on pallets protected from rainfall. Avoid excessive compaction.

Shelf life is 12 months when stored as above, in original, unopened bags.
